In answer to your letter of the 7th Inst. I have much pleasure in forwarding, in accordance with your wishes, the enclosed list of the birds which you discovered in Nepal since 1844, together with the corrected names of some of those previously sent. The species pertaining to the Rasorial, Gallatorial & Scatatorial groups I have not as yet worked out (but which I hope to do at some future time), the names of these

in the list, are upon the authority
of Mr J. R. Gray. I hope it
will answer your purpose.

I believe I mentioned when
you were last here, that a
change would probably take
place in regard to our Natural
History Museum - and that I
was anxious to obtain testimony
regarding my friends for taking
charge, as Liberator, of their
Collection. I therefore take
this opportunity of expressing
the wishes of one from yourself,
and with your kind permission,
I should be grateful to

permitted.
